CONDITIONS & GUARANTEES: All entries sell with a responsible breeders guarantee of satisfaction. In the unlikely event of any dispute whatever, regular TERMS & CONDITIONS shall apply in accordance with the Canadian Angus Association Code of Ethics.

ALL CATTLE ARE SOLD subject to tests as required for export under Regulations of the Health of Animals Branch, Department of Agriculture for Canada. Export health chart and brokerage charges are the responsibility of the purchaser.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Cash or cheque payable to the Clerk of Sale on Sale Day. U.S. Funds will be accepted at the current Rate of Exchange on sale day.

INSURANCE: Ownership risk to Purchaser commences when Auctioneer's hammer falls. Full Mortality Insurance is available sale day. Cattle returning to Moose Creek Red Angus after the sale must be insured.

HOLDING & SHIPPING: Approximately one week is required for export transfers and other documents to be processed. Export animals will be held at the Sale location at no charge and under excellent care. Joint export shipping arrangements to obtain minimal shipping cost will gladly be made if instructions to that effect are provided to Clerk of Sale at time of settlements.

TRUCKING: Free trucking will be available to the prairie provinces at the purchasers convenience before May 1, 2009. Delivery after

May 1, 2009 will be at a mutually agreed upon time for both parties. Most of the deliveries will be to your yard but some may be to central locations due to load size and time. If the truck is headed past your yard, expect your bull to be on the load.

OWNERS: reserve the right to withhold from export shipment animals for whom Buyer or Buyer's agent have not made arrangements for payment in full, or other satisfactory arrangements, prior to time of export departure.

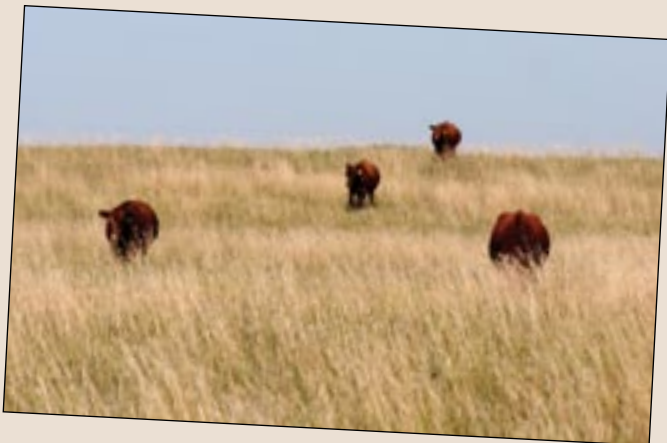

This is the first set of Charolais bulls to be offered. The same criteria that has made our Red Angus such a success is used when managing our white herd.

The Charolais cows must calve unassisted with an appropriate sized calf, re breed in a 50 day period and be hard working and efficient. Both the Charolais and Red Angus cows winter together so they must also be moderate, big bodied and very sound. As you can tell, the white cows will have no special treatment so they must compete and be as hardy as our red cows.

The numbers will continue to grow but for the first year we have only cataloged 2 bulls that have passed the culling criteria.

I am certain that they will meet your approval and that the foundation has been laid for a very good complimentary breed choice in our sale.

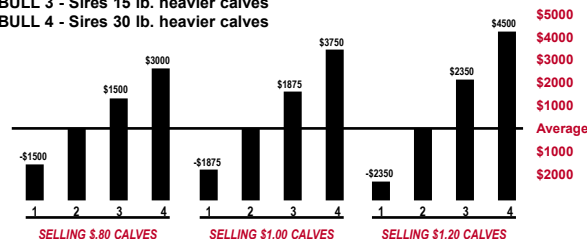

WHAT'S A BULL WORTH

The graph indicates the possible differences in values of 4 bulls siring 125 calves in a lifetime. One bull sires average calves, one sires calves 15 pounds lighter at weaning, one sires calves 15 pounds heavier at weaning, one sires calves 30 pounds heavier at weaning. This graph only indicates the value considering weaning weights. The increase or decrease in value due to calving ease, the production of daughters, feedlot gain and efficiency, yearling growth, carcass traits etc. could easily double or triple these differences.

POSSIBLE DIFFERENCES IN VALUES OF 4 BULLS - SIRING 125 CALVES PER LIFETIME

- BULL 1 - Sires 15 lb. lighter calves
- BULL 2 - Sires average calves
- BULL 3 - Sires 15 lb. heavier calves
- BULL 4 - Sires 30 lb. heavier calves





Duster

An amazing breeding piece, more commercial customers call him by name than any other bull that we have ever used. And why wouldn't they. The daughters are dominating our cowherd with their beautiful udders, striking presence and hard working production. This bull still seems to dominate in any mating we use him in. Hairy, muscular and loose made; sometimes when I describe them I run out of adjectives...



Doc

Our main heifer bull; we stumbled upon Doc over the phone one evening. When one of the most honest breeders tells you he has a good one, you better investigate. Great calving ease, tremendous maternal power and an amazing rate of gain and conversion rate sold us on Doc. Not to mention he came from the same place that our high seller in the estate sale came from. Good programs breed good cattle.



Mex-Kargo

Mex is a bull that the older he gets the more valuable he becomes to us as breeding bull. As you can see, his sons have tremendous performance and gain ability. His milking daughters are showing that they can mother herd bulls too. Buy and use Mex genetics confidently, they are consistent and proven.



Olympian

The true breeding strength of Olympian is just being discovered. His huge performance yet moderate size makes him unique to most other bulls. He consistently sires the same cattle; dense made, clean cut, hard muscled cattle that have blown their pen mates away when taken to slaughter. But if you think that he is only a "carcass" bull, the tour thru his young daughters nursing may make you realize his breeding strength is only starting to be discovered.

Why a late April sale?

Well this is quite simple. The commercial cattlemen that we sell to have moved their calving back. With that, they have also moved back semen testing, and bull shopping.

This later sale gives them ample time to test their herd bulls without doing it in the dead of winter. Also, these same cattlemen are just in the middle of calving so they are aware of the kind of grief or success they are having. Pretty dumb to replace your heifer bull in February when you won't have started to calf to him until April?

Having a later sale makes the days longer and warmer therefore you don't have to rush home to save the ears on a calf. We also moved the sale time back to 3:00 pm so anyone traveling doesn't have to rush through morning chores to make the sale.

We moved the lunch until after the sale to give a more casual atmosphere where we can enjoy good company, good food and the odd laugh.

We hope that these changes give more of a commercial feel to our sale as they are the clients that we cater to-not the purebred crowd.



Why are you always talking about cows at a bull sale?

Easy, our cows have bought and paid for everything on our ranch. We are not businessman that have jobs to supplement our cattle operation, we make our money the exact same way

as our customers do.

Strict culling, exhausting research and let's be honest, a little luck, has put us where we are in the cattle business. Since we calve out every female born each year and cull 70% of them after their first calf, you can bet you are getting the best we have to offer. This process allows us to evaluate traits that can't be measured on calves and yearlings.

We don't need to gather cows just to have numbers, we would rather sell 40 good bulls than 100 "alright" ones. Udder quality, easy fleshing, fertility, production and most importantly feet, are the criteria for our herd. Our cow herd is an intricate web of proven cow families. This helps us stack udder quality and production many generations deep.

When we buy a bull, the first thing we need to see is his mother and sisters. The bulls we own need to be wide based, thick made, extremely correct and deep bodied. Our customers want sons that look like this so we need to breed to bulls like this.



How are your bulls fed?

Our bulls are fed a gentle TMR ration that consists of Barley silage, alfalfa, straw and high protein grain screening pellet. The TMR ration guarantees that the first bite is the same as the last bite making sure no bull ends up with more grain than the next. This was designed for our bulls by our nutritionist. We don't feed a 'generic' ration that is suited for bulls. This is our ration designed with the bulls age, size, breed and longevity in mind. We find that our bulls are lighter conditioned than others out there but weigh about the same. This shows the 'true' muscle that they carry.

These bulls are run in a large feedlot pen with access to a paddock. This kind of housing makes a leaner, harder muscled bull, one designed for the breeding pasture, not the show ring.
