Any buyer purchasing three or more bulls of any breed will receive 5% off of purchase price. This can be used in conjunction with the "haul your own" discount.

CONDITIONS & GUARANTEES: All entries sell with a responsible breeder's guarantee of satisfaction. In the unlikely event of any dispute whatever, regular TERMS & CONDITIONS shall apply in accordance with the Canadian Angus and Charlolais Association Code of Ethics.

ALL CATTLE ARE SOLD subject to tests as required for export under Regulations of the Health of Animals Branch, Department of Agriculture for Canada. Export health chart and brokerage charges are the responsibility of the purchaser.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Cash or cheque payable to the Clerk of Sale on Sale Day. U.S. Funds will be accepted at the current Rate of Exchange on sale day.

INSURANCE: Ownership risk to Purchaser commences when Auctioneer's hammer falls. Full

Mortality Insurance is available sale day. Cattle returning to Moose Creek Red Angus after the sale must be insured.

HOLDING & SHIPPING: Approximately one week is required for export transfers and other documents to be processed. Export animals will be held at the Sale location at no charge and under excellent care. Joint export shipping arrangements to obtain minimal shipping cost will gladly be made if instructions to that effect are provided to Clerk of Sale at time of settlements.

TRUCKING: Free trucking will be available to the Prairie Provinces at the purchaser's convenience before May 1, 2016. Delivery after May 1, 2016 will be at a mutually agreed upon time for both parties. Most deliveries will be to your

yard but some may be to central locations due to load size and time. If the truck is headed past your yard, expect your bull to be on the load. Anyone taking advantage of the free trucking must insure their bulls. No exceptions.

HAUL YOUR OWN: Bring your trailer sale day and receive a \$250 discount per bull.

OWNERS: Reserve the right to withhold from export shipment animals for whom Buyer or Buyer's agent have not made arrangements for payment in full, or other satisfactory arrangements, prior to time of export departure.

ALL PERSONS who attend the Sale do so at their own risk, and the Owners and Sale Staff assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for property loss or for any accidents that may occur.

DEVELOPMENT & DELIVERY

We will continue to develop your newly purchased herd sire(s) for you at no cost. The only thing we ask is that you insure your purchase for the duration that he is being developed. The bulls staying until spring will be semen checked and delivered to you in April/May, or as loads develop for your area. For anyone wanting to develop their own bulls, a rebate of \$250 per bull will be subtracted from the purchase price. This applies to any bulls taken sale day or delivered within seven days of the sale.

SEMEN CHECKING

All of the bulls in the sale have been vet inspected, palpated and scrotal measured prior to going to grass in the spring and again prior to the sale. None of the bulls selling have been semen checked. Most veterinarians agree that semen checking is only valid for up to 30 days post testing. Any of the bulls selling are fully guaranteed; if they happen to be incapable of settling cows, a replacement bull will be supplied until a suitable bull is available. Credit for the incapable bull may be used at any Moose Creek sale on any breed of bull. At no point shall the compensation be greater than the purchase price.

Relic was one of the stoutest, hairiest herd sires to sell in the spring of 2012. He exhibited tons of muscle expression, huge base width and large testicles. This is the last set of sons available.

For a decade now, we have been developing and breeding Charolais genetics. Our herd has grown from one cow to nearly 70 cows and back to 20 breeding females. The expansion and culling was in order to select the type of Charolais that will flourish in the systems that we and our clientele use. Cattle that are easy calving, vigorous at birth and maternal, while still not losing focus on the superior traits that Charolais possess: performance based, stout, hairy, big pay-weight stock. We have not worked to downsize the white cows, however we have been successful at making them easier fleshing, lower maintenance and harder working.



BULLDEVELOPMENT

All of the bulls in the sale have been developed together since birth. We do not use co-operator herds or have guest consignors. The bulls are vaccinated at birth, branding and weaning. Our cowherd is one of only a select few PI BVD free herds in Canada. We gained this status in 2004 and have kept it since.

The bulls are weaned and developed on a growing ration consisting of silage, hay, supplement and corn to meet energy requirements. They are fed moderately to gain 2.5 lbs/day and given plenty of exercise. After being vet inspected in the spring, the entire sale offering was sent to pasture April 5 and stayed out grazing until October 19. We brought them back to the yard, started them on a corn silage, hay, supplement and corn grain ration. They have been fed and managed as one group, with plenty of running room in the adjacent paddock.

We are confident that the offering is sound and developed with their longevity and long term soundness in mind.

PERFORMANCEDATA

WHAT IS 'OGW'? OFF-GRASS WEIGHT

All of the performance data supplied are actuals with no adjustments. Our weaning weights are based on pay weight in the fall, just the same as you sell your calves. We have supplied actual yearling weights and off-grass weights as well. It is important to us to provide you with these numbers, un-manipulated, as you can determine the emphasis you put on each one.

Our birth weights are recorded as close to 24 hours post calving as possible and again, they are not adjusted to factor age of dam, days on feed or cow size. We do not post calving ease scores on the bulls selling because they are all born unassisted or they are culled. Same goes for a disposition score.

The sale offering has been handled numerous times, and each time on foot. Any uncooperative bulls are culled. The final test prior to selling is each bull being separated and singly pictured and videoed with 2-3 people in the pen with them. All of the flighty, high-headed bulls are long gone. This is still a family run industry and no one has time for wild cattle.

GENOMICS THE NEW TOOL FOR THE 21ST CENTURY

NEW DNA TEST COULD PROVIDE KEY TO PROFIT "Testing for the leptin gene in livestock is a new cutting edge proposition associated with DNA gene markers. The IGENITY-L[™] test, provided by Merial, allows producers to utilize yet another tool in beef production to improve carcass merit. "Leptin is a protein produced in white fat tissue and the more leptin produced, the stronger the signal is sent to the brain to reduce appetite," Tate says. "The leptin protein is directly related to appetite, energy utilization and fat deposition." (Clifford, 2005).

RFI (Residual Feed Intake) testing. "An efficient bull will pass on superior genetics for feed efficiency to his progeny, which will be realized as feed savings for calves in the feedlot and for replacement heifers entering the cowherd." (From: http://www1.agric.gov.ab.ca/\$department/deptdocs.nsf/ all/agdex10861).

The Effect of Leptin on Average Daily Gain and Feed Efficiency:

The particular gene being examined produces leptin, which is associated with appetite. Cattle with the fully mutated form of leptin (genotype TT) put on weight faster than those with the slightly mutated form (genotype CT) which put on weight faster than those with the non mutated form of leptin (genotype CC). (From: <u>http://www.innovationplace.com/thescene/news/56.html</u>)

- Leptin positive animals finish for slaughter approximately **37 days faster** and had an **ADG of 3.323** compared with non-positive animals that had an ADG of 2.937.
- Leptin positive animals also exhibit a greater feed efficiency (6.4) compared to non-positive animals (8.2). (Quantum Management Protocol)

Yield Grade:

Although the results vary in terms of the proportion that grade AAA or higher, the trend has always been the same:

TT cattle have a much higher chance of AAA, or in the USA system "choice".

Milk Production:

Prior research indicates that a SNP at position 305 of exon 2 in the leptin gene affects milk production in dairy cows. Dairy cows with at least one copy of the T allele have been shown to have higher milk production than CC cows. If that effect carries over to beef breeds, it is reasonable to expect that CT and TT beef cows will wean heavier calves than CC beef cows. We tested this hypothesis for a herd of mixed breed cows using anova.

Results indicated that both crossbred CT and TT beef cows wean significantly heavier beef calves than CC crossbred beef cows. (Anim Genet. 2008 Jun;39(3):284-6. doi: 10.1111/j. The impact of a leptin gene SNP on beef calf weaning weights. DeVuyst EA, Bauer ML, Cheng FC, Mitchell J, Larson D.)


